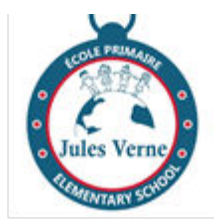

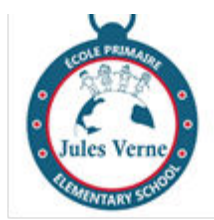

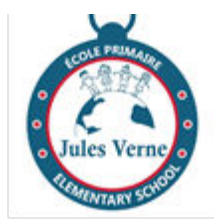

Projected Enrollment 2025-26

As of May 6, we are at 12,624 students registered. 57 fewer students compared to the 2024-25 enrollment. Improvement from March, where we were at a decrease of 150 students. Improvement from decrease experienced from 2023-24 to 2024-25 which was 113 students less.

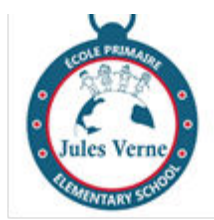
